HOUSE BILL NO. 1180

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety;

requiring the State Board of Health to adopt rules requiring hospitals to provide a list of services and who will be billing for those services to patients; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-707c of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Board of Health shall adopt rules requiring every hospital, as defined in Section 1-710 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to provide to each patient upon discharge or upon the completion of treatment a list of the services, equipment, supplies and drugs or medicines provided to the patient and each health care provider or entity which will be billing the patient for those services, equipment, supplies and drugs or medicines.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
