AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Personnel Act;
requiring reimbursement for uniforms; providing for
codification; providing an effective date; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.28 of Title 74, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All employees in either the classified or unclassified service
shall be entitled to be reimbursed for the actual cost of a uniform
which is required to be worn by the employee during the performance
of duties and responsibilities of the position for which the
employee was hired.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
