AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to military service; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 2-307.4, which relates to military service benefits; and clarifying language.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 2-307.4, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2-307.4 A. Any member of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System with military service prior to membership in the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System shall be granted service credit, not to exceed five (5) years, for those periods of active military service during which he or she was a war veteran. Such military service credit shall not apply to any person receiving military retirement benefits other than service-connected disability benefits established by either the military service or the Veterans Administration.

B. As used in this section, "military service" means service in the Armed Forces of the United States in time of war or national emergency, as defined in Section 67.13a of Title 72 of the Oklahoma Statutes, from which the member was honorably discharged.

C. Service credit received pursuant to this section shall be used in determining the member's retirement benefit but shall not be used in determining years of service for retirement or vesting purposes.
