AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government and labor;
prohibiting certain sensitivity training;
specifying such prohibition; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-3.1a of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The state or any governmental subdivision of the state shall not offer or require any employee to take any training or teaching which is designed to put homosexual, lesbian or bisexual lifestyles in a favorable light.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 191.1 of Title 40, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No private employer in this state shall offer or require any employee to take any training or teaching which is designed to put homosexual, lesbian or bisexual lifestyles in a favorable light.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
