HOUSE BILL NO. 1281

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to agriculture; amending 2 O.S. 1991, Section 10-21, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 126, O.S.L. 1994 (2 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 10-21), which relates to poultry; updating and clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 1991, Section 10-21, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 126, O.S.L. 1994 (2 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 10-21), is amended to read as follows:

Section 10-21. There is hereby established in the State of Oklahoma a State Poultry Show, which shall be held annually under the supervision of the Oklahoma State Poultry Federation in accordance with rules ~~and regulations~~ promulgated by the State Board of Agriculture. ~~Such~~ The show shall be held at a central point in ~~the State of Oklahoma~~ this state designated by the Oklahoma State Poultry Federation, in December of each year, and any or all of the expenses thereof may be paid from any funds that have been made available for such purpose to the State Department of Agriculture or the State Board of Agriculture, on claims approved by the State

Board of Agriculture. The State Poultry Show shall be divided into two divisions, as follows:

1. Adult or Open Division. Any person raising poultry may exhibit in such Division. Entry fees and premiums shall be fixed by the State Board of Agriculture in cooperation, and after consultation, with the Oklahoma State Poultry Federation or its representatives. Nonresident exhibitor premiums shall be paid from entry fees collected by the Oklahoma State Poultry Federation; and

2. Junior Division. An exhibitor in such division shall be a boy or girl between the ages of nine (9) and nineteen (19) years, and participation in the Junior Divisions of all contests in school district, county, and state poultry and egg shows shall be limited to specimens of poultry and eggs actually produced and raised by school children of such district, county, and the state, respectively, between the ages hereinabove specified.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
