AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to tourism and recreation; providing that a violation of a Tourism Department rule relating to use of public recreation facilities shall constitute a misdemeanor; establishing penalty; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1811A of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Except as otherwise provided by law, any person who violates any rule for the use of public recreation facilities promulgated by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission pursuant to Section 1811 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof may be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each violation or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six (6) months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
