HOUSE BILL NO. 1414

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; stating legislative concern and awareness of need to involve parents in certain school activities; prohibiting student involvement in certain school activities without parental authorization; providing for codification; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The Oklahoma Legislature is aware that students may become involved in special extracurricular activities and fund raising activities for the school or private concerns sponsored by the school in which the parent may not always be made aware of prior to participation. Even though the activity may be voluntary, the Oklahoma Legislature recognizes that a parent should be made aware of the activity and be involved in the decision to allow the student to participate.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-151 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No student shall be allowed to participate in special extracurricular activities and fund-raising activities sponsored by

the school in which the student attends unless a parent or guardian of the student authorizes in writing such participation.

SECTION 3. NONCODIFICATION Section 1 of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
