HOUSE BILL NO. 1420

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to game and fish; authorizing the Wildlife Conservation Commission to establish certain fees; stating categories of fees; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-137 of Title 29, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Wildlife Conservation Commission may establish, by rule promulgated in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, reasonable fees for the following:

1. Use of lands owned, leased or operated by the Department of Wildlife Conservation for purposes not related to hunting or fishing by persons who do not possess a valid Oklahoma hunting or fishing license at the time of such use; and

2. Special services or programs provided by the Department including, but not limited to, guided tours for viewing wildlife or special features in natural areas.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
