AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to railroads; amending 66 O.S. 1991, Section 125, which relates to neglect of railroad signs at crossings; updating statutory reference; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 66 O.S. 1991, Section 125, is amended to read as follows:

Section 125. In case any railroad corporation shall refuse or neglect, for a space of thirty (30) days after notice given by the board of county commissioners, to comply with the provisions of ~~the preceding section~~ Section 124 of this title, it shall become the duty of the county commissioners of each county through which any such railroad shall be in operation to erect such signs, and the company shall be liable for all expenses so incurred by said commissioners.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
