HOUSE BILL NO. 1444

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 1991, Section 1210.199, which relates to cardiopulmonary resuscitation programs; requiring teachers and support employees to have CPR training; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 1991, Section 1210.199, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1210.199 A. All students enrolled in physical education in classes in grades nine through twelve in the public schools of this state may receive instruction in the techniques of cardiopulmonary resuscitation sufficient to enable such students to give emergency assistance to victims of cardiac arrest.

B. All teachers and support employees as defined in Section 1-116 of this title shall receive instruction in the techniques of cardiopulmonary resuscitation sufficient to enable such teachers and support employees to give emergency assistance to victims of cardiac arrest.

C. The State Department of Education may administer the cardiopulmonary resuscitation instruction program and train teaching

personnel pursuant to ~~regulations~~ rules adopted by the State Board of Education. Teaching materials and training courses provided by the American Heart Association and similar organizations may be utilized.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
