AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to criminal procedure; amending 22 O.S. 1991, Section 742, which relates to accomplice testimony; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 22 O.S. 1991, Section 742, is amended to read as follows:

Section 742. A conviction cannot be had upon the testimony of an accomplice unless ~~he~~ the accomplice be corroborated by such other evidence as tends to connect the defendant with the commission of the offense, and the corroboration is not sufficient if it merely show the commission of the offense or the circumstances thereof.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
