AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce; enacting the Bio-Technology Agricultural Products Incentive Reform Act; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5065.9 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Bio-Technology Agricultural Products Incentive Reform Act".

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
