HOUSE BILL NO. 1530

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; creating the Assisted Living Services Act; providing for purpose; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-845.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Assisted Living Services Act".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-845.2 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The purpose of the Assisted Living Services Act is to contribute to the development of a comprehensive system of long-term care by encouraging the establishment of community-based, assisted living services programs that provide a homelike environment for older persons and persons with developmental, physical and/or mental disabilities who need assistance with activities of daily living.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
