AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of Tourism  
and Recreation; stating certain budget categories;  
providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
limiting the salary of the Director; providing  
budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent  
employees; providing an effective date; and  
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the  
Oklahoma Department of Tourism and Recreation shall budget all funds  
in the following categories and amounts:

The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Tourism and Recreation by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998. The Oklahoma Department of Tourism and Recreation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitation on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
