AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma House of

Representatives; requiring the Speaker of the House
of Representatives to approve claims and payrolls;
providing an effective date; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. Claims and payrolls filed against the appropriations
made to the House of Representatives for the fiscal year ending June
30, 1998, shall be approved by the Speaker of the House of
Representatives.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
