AS INTRODUCED

An Act funding the state correctional system; making an appropriation to the Department of Corrections; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the Pardon and Parole Board; stating purpose; providing lapse date; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Corrections from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Corrections by law.

PARDON AND PAROLE BOARD

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Pardon and Parole Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Pardon and Parole Board by law.

SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1998. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1998, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
