AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to supplemental funding of various state entities; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Department of Corrections; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Department of Tourism and Recreation; stating purpose; making certain appropriations nonfiscal; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Corrections from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Corrections by law.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Tourism and Recreation from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the sum of _____ Dollars

(\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Tourism and Recreation by law.

SECTION 3. The appropriations made by Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
