AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to appropriations; making an
appropriation to the Oklahoma Conservation
Commission; stating purpose; providing lapse date;
and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
Conservation Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated
from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of _____ Dollars
(\$_____.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the
duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Conservation Commission by law.

SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall be subject
to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30,
1998. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1998, shall
lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the
then current fiscal year.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
