AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to oil and gas; amending Section 2, Chapter 185, O.S.L. 1993 (52 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 420.17), which relates to certain allowance for Liquefied Petroleum Gas Inspectors; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 185, O.S.L. 1993 (52 O.S. Supp. 1996, Section 420.17), is amended to read as follows:

Section 420.17 An expense allowance of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per month for maintenance and cleaning of uniforms and other related expenses shall be paid to Liquefied Petroleum Gas Inspectors. Nothing in this section regarding expense allowances shall be construed to mean that ~~such~~ employees shall receive any additional compensation beyond what is provided for maintenance and cleaning of uniforms and other related expenses by the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board on the effective date of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
