HOUSE BILL NO. 1979

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to transportation; making an appropriation to the Department of Transportation; specifying purpose; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Transportation from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00), for the purpose of matching federal construction funds to build a four-lane highway beginning in the vicinity of the intersection of the Oklahoma-Arkansas border and U.S. Highway 70 and extending westward to connect with I-35 in the vicinity of Ardmore.

SECTION 2. It is the intent of the Legislature that the appropriation made in Section 1 of this act be made from growth money for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998. For the purposes of this act, growth money shall be defined as funds derived from the increase in appropriations authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998 over the appropriations authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, as determined by the certification of funds

available by the State Board of Equalization pursuant to the provisions of Section 23 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
