HOUSE BILL NO. 1988

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to insurance; requiring notice of issuance of certain vehicle insurance policies; providing that section is part of Oklahoma Insurance Code; providing for codification; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1231 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

If an insurer issues a policy of vehicle insurance, as defined by Section 706 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the insurer shall give the purchaser of the policy written notice if the policy is a policy issued pursuant to Section 7-501 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes or if the policy is designated a high-risk policy for which the purchaser is being charged a higher premium than normally charged for the coverage, based on some characteristic of the insured, such as age or prior driving record.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall constitute a part of Article 12 of the Oklahoma Insurance Code.

SECTION 3. Section 2 of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
