AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to agriculture; limiting number of swine on certain acreage; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9-213.1 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

On and after November 1, 1997, no swine animal feeding operation established primarily for finishing swine shall have more than one thousand swine over fifty-five (55) pounds located on a one-hundred-sixty-acre tract.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
