AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to revenue and taxation; amending 68 O.S. 1991, Section 209, which relates to notice to attorney for Oklahoma Tax Commission before judicial hearings; modifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 1991, Section 209, is amended to read as follows:

Section 209. No court of this state shall hear or try any case in which the Tax Commission is a party plaintiff, defendant or intervener, until it has been made to appear to ~~said~~ the court that notice of the time and place of said hearing has been given by registered or certified mail, for at least ten (10) days, to the attorney of the Tax Commission. ~~Such~~ The notice shall be given by the court clerk and the cost thereof taxed as court costs in the case.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
