HOUSE BILL NO. 2108

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce; making an appropriation; stating purposes; exempting certain contracts from the Central Purchasing Act; providing a lapse date; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of Nine Hundred Eighty-five Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars (\$985,367.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of funding a Dual Use Training Center to implement the "Commerce at Light Speed" (CAL S) initiative by providing training, CAL S implementation, outreach and information sharing to Oklahoma businesses that will improve their access to data, data management, automation processes and industrial competitiveness.

SECTION 2. The funds appropriated and expended for the Dual Use Training Center shall be exempt from the requirements of the Central Purchasing Act, Section 85.1 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. The appropriations made by Section 1 of this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1998. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1998, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
