AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;  
requiring the Commissioner of Public Safety to  
adopt and promulgate rules for a certain purpose;  
providing for codification; and declaring an  
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-108.1 of Title 47, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Commissioner of Public Safety shall adopt and promulgate  
rules pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act, specifying  
guidelines for the use of state airplanes.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
