AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to environment and natural resources;  
establishing a cost sharing program with county  
commissioners for noxious weed eradication;  
requiring matching; providing for codification;  
providing an effective date; and declaring an  
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-2-110 of Title 27A, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Conservation Commission shall establish and  
administer in conjunction with county commissioners a cost sharing  
program for the eradication of noxious weeds as provided in Section  
3-220 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Any monies appropriated  
to or monies otherwise directed by the Commission for such program  
must be matched by the county commissioners on a one-to-one basis  
with either monies or in-kind services including but not limited to  
equipment and labor.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
