AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 2-105.2, which relates to Public Safety Patrol Schools; requiring school to be conducted under certain circumstance; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 2-105.2, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2-105.2 The Department of Public Safety ~~is authorized to shall~~ conduct Public Safety Patrol Schools ~~as may be required and within~~ whenever the number of uniformed commissioned members of the highway patrol falls below seven hundred fifty (750) with the funds available to the Department for that purpose. ~~Provided, however, that no~~ No such school will be commenced nor any funds expended therefor until each individual school has been approved for implementation by the Contingency Review Board.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1997.
