AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety;  
prohibiting expenditure of public funds by  
governmental entities for condoms to prevent Human  
Acquired Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV); providing  
for codification; providing an effective date; and  
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-534.3 of Title 63, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No funds appropriated to any state agency, board, commission,  
department or other entity of state government or funds made  
available to any local governmental agency or entity through an  
appropriation of any money to any state agency, board, commission,  
department or other entity of state government shall be expended for  
the purpose of providing condoms for the prevention of the Human  
Acquired Immunodeficiency Virus ("HIV").

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1997.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
