HOUSE BILL NO. 2294

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to telephone companies; directing the Corporation Commission to create certain Wide Area Calling Plans; providing that the boundaries of the Plans be the area code boundaries; requiring action to be revenue neutral; providing a date for activation of the Plans; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 139.602 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Corporation Commission shall take action as necessary to cause the creation of three Wide Area Calling Plans in the state, the boundaries of which shall be the boundaries of each of the three area codes in the state. The Plans shall be Area Code Wide Area Calling Plans and shall allow toll free calling within an area code.

B. The creation of the Area Code Wide Area Calling Plans shall be revenue neutral to each affected local exchange company.

C. The Area Code Wide Area Calling Plans shall be activated no later than January 1, 1999.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
