AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to blind persons; renaming title;
providing for composition of title; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5001 of Title 7, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Title 7 of the Oklahoma Statutes currently entitled "Blind Persons" shall be renamed as "Blind, Deaf and Disabled Individuals".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5002 of Title 7, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This title shall be composed of five articles:

Article I shall be titled "General Definitions";

Article II shall be titled "Oklahoma Rehabilitation Services Act";

Article III shall be titled "Blind and Visually Impaired Individuals";

Article IV shall be titled "Deaf and Hearing Impaired Individuals"; and

Article V shall be titled "Individuals with Disabilities".

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
