HOUSE BILL NO. 2528

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; creating the Oklahoma Health Care Authority Act; providing for content of articles; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5000 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be Chapter 3 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes and shall be entitled "Oklahoma Health Care Authority Act".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5001 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This chapter shall be composed of six articles:

Article I shall be titled "General Definitions";

Article II shall be titled "Administration of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority";

Article III shall be titled "State Medicaid Program";

Article IV shall be titled "Health Care Information System";

Article V shall be titled "State and Education Employees Health Care Benefits"; and

Article VI shall be titled "Health Benefits for Employed, Uninsured and Medically Indigent Persons".

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
