HOUSE BILL NO. 2537

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to professions and occupations;
stating legislative intent relating to private
associations and fees; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1063 of Title 59, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Legislature in many distinct ways tries to protect
its citizenry from acts which are unfair to the working class. When
workers are forced to join organizations and associations in order
to be taxpaying citizens and employed, it is necessary for the
members of those organizations or associations to have a vote on the
raising or lowering of fees. A simple majority vote by the
membership would be fair for the raising or lowering of these fees.
The Oklahoma Legislature intends to follow the trends regarding
these organizations and associations to see if future legislation
might be necessary.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
