AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; submitting to a vote of the people a measure to repeal 47 O.S. 1991, Section 12-417, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 290, O.S.L. 1997 (47 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 12-417), which relates to mandatory use of seat belts for front seat passengers; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided for by law, Section 2 of this act.

SECTION 2. REPEALER 47 O.S. 1991, Section 12-417, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 290, O.S.L. 1997 (47 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 12-417), is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. The Ballot Title for the proposed act shall be in the following form:

THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

This measure would repeal a section of Oklahoma law. The law is Section 12-417 of Title 47. The law requires persons in the

front seat of a car to wear seat belts. If it is repealed, it will no longer be against the law to drive or ride in the front seat of a car without wearing a seat belt.

SECTION 4. The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives, immediately after the passage of this act, shall prepare and file one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 3 hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the Attorney General.
