AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 1991, Section 11-103.2, which relates to the academic scholar program; deleting obsolete statutory language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 1991, Section 11-103.2, is amended to read as follows:

Section 11-103.2 The State Board of Education shall have authority to develop and implement a program for the purpose of recognizing academic scholars in the secondary schools of the state. The State Board of Education shall determine the requirements which are necessary for a student to attain academic scholar status. The requirements shall include but not be limited to the minimum graduation requirements set by the State Board of Education. Recognition for academic scholar status shall be indicated upon the diploma of those students who qualify for such status and in such other manner as the Board may determine. The State Board of Education shall be authorized to promulgate rules ~~and regulations~~ in order to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
