AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to professions and occupations;
amending 59 O.S. 1991, Section 46.25, which relates
to approval by architects; providing exemption for
approval of certain plans or specifications;
requiring approval of engineer or architect prior
to certain events; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 1991, Section 46.25, is amended to read as follows:

Section 46.25 A. Each licensed architect shall have a seal, the image of which must contain the name of the architect, his place of business and the words, "Licensed Architect, State of Oklahoma".

~~The~~ B. Except as otherwise provided by this section, the seal shall be affixed upon all contract drawings, specifications and all addenda issued by the architect whether for use in this state or elsewhere.

C. It shall be unlawful for a licensed architect to affix the seal, or to permit it to be affixed, upon drawings or specifications which were not prepared under the architect's personal and direct supervision.

D. The seal of an architect shall not be required to be affixed to the plans or specifications for a premanufactured building or other structure if the building or structure has been approved by an engineer or an architect during the initial construction or fabrication of the building or structure or after its initial construction or fabrication, but prior to the date as of which the building or structure or its components are delivered in this state to a public trust, or the city, town or county which is the beneficiary of a public trust, for use in an economic development project involving the occupancy of the building or structure by a private business entity.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
