HOUSE BILL NO. 2660

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; creating the Oklahoma Quality Schools Act; stating purposes of the Act; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.901 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Quality Schools Act".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.902 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The purpose of the Oklahoma Quality Schools Act is to:

1. Encourage parental and community involvement in the public schools;
2. Revitalize the public schools through the use of current deregulation opportunities for innovative programs, school sites and schools districts;

3. Create parent councils for each school site which will work to improve the school. The school site parent council members shall be appointed by the curriculum council at each school site; and

4. Initiate reforms arrived at through site-based decision making.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1998.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
