AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the State Insurance Fund; amending 85 O.S. 1991, Section 145, as amended by Section 10, Chapter 363, O.S.L. 1996 (85 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 145), which relates to records; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 85 O.S. 1991, Section 145, as amended by Section 10, Chapter 363, O.S.L. 1996 (85 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 145), is amended to read as follows:

Section 145. Every person, firm, or corporation who ~~has~~ is insured ~~in~~ by "The State Insurance Fund" shall keep a true and accurate record of the number of employees and the wages paid and shall furnish upon demand a sworn statement of the same. The record shall be open to inspection at any time, and as often as may be necessary to verify the number of employees and the amount of the payroll. Any person, firm, or corporation who shall willfully fail to keep the required records or who shall willfully falsify any such record, shall be guilty of a felony.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
