AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Corporation Commission;
authorizing the Commission to employ expert
witnesses for certain matters; providing for
codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18 of Title 17, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Corporation Commission is authorized to employ expert
witnesses to prepare and present testimony in matters pending before
the Commission or in matters concerning the Commission pending in
other state or federal forums.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
