AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Medicaid; directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to take certain actions related to certain state employees; providing for eligibility for Medicaid services for certain state employees under certain circumstances; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1010.1A of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall take all necessary action, including but not limited to the preparation and submission of waiver requests to the appropriate federal officials, to assure that employees of the State of Oklahoma who are financially or otherwise eligible shall be eligible for services pursuant to Titles XIX and XXI of the federal Social Security Act through the State Medicaid Program.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
