AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; amending
63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-107, which relates to the
Public Health Special Fund; clarifying language;
and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-107, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 1-107. A. There is hereby created in the State
Treasury a revolving fund to be known as the Public Health Special
Fund. All monies, fees and revenues collected, authorized or
received from any source by the State Commissioner of Health or the
State Department of Health ~~under~~ pursuant to the provisions of this
Code or any other law or any agreement shall, unless otherwise
expressly provided in this Code or other law, be placed in said
fund. ~~Said~~

B. The fund shall be a continuing fund not subject to fiscal
year limitations.

C. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby
appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Commissioner
for the purpose of maintaining and operating the State Department of

Health, and in administering and executing the laws pertaining to the duties and functions of the State Department of Health.

D. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
