AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to cemeteries; requiring all cemeteries to provide notice of all rates prior to a burial; requiring such notice be provided to the State Banking Commissioner; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1b of Title 8, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Each municipal, religious, fraternal, corporate, rural or nonprofit entity, free community burial ground, county cemetery association, charitable or eleemosynary institution and for-profit entity operating cemeteries in this state shall provide each customer with notice of all rates on services and merchandise associated with the burial prior to the burial. These rates shall be provided to the State Banking Commissioner by the cemetery entity within five (5) working days of being set by the entity.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
