AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; amending Section 4, Chapter 303, O.S.L. 1997 (70 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 3218.14), relating to fees and tuition; and clarifying language.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 303, O.S.L. 1997 (70 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 3218.14), is amended to read as follows:

Section 3218.1 Each institution and constituent agency within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education shall have the option to recommend to the governing board and to the State Regents fees and tuition to be charged to students enrolled at the institution or constituent agency. The fees and tuition shall not exceed the limits established by law. The State Regents shall consider and if appropriate, shall approve the recommendations of the institution or constituent agency pursuant to Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution.
