AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to prevention of discriminatory treatment; making appropriations to the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth, the Office of Handicapped Concerns, the Human Rights Commission, and the Indian Affairs Commission; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth by law.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of Handicapped Concerns from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much

thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of Handicapped Concerns by law.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Human Rights Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Human Rights Commission by law.

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Indian Affairs Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Indian Affairs Commission by law.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective September 1, 1998.
