AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the State Department of
Rehabilitation Services; providing for duties and
compensation of employees in the State Department
of Rehabilitation Services; limiting the salary of
the Director and the number of full-time-equivalent
employees; providing budgetary limitations; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

STATE DEPARTMENT OF REHABILITATION SERVICES

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not
otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
upon the State Department of Rehabilitation Services by law shall be
set by the Commission for Rehabilitation Services. The salary of
the Director shall not exceed Sixty-three Thousand Six Hundred
Twenty-nine Dollars (\$63,629.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
fiscal year ending June 30, 1999. The State Department of
Rehabilitation Services for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999,

shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1998.
