AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 1991, Section 4-120, as last amended by Section 19, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 1994 (26 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 4-120), which relates to voter registration; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 1991, Section 4-120, as last amended by Section 19, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 1994 (26 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 4-120), is amended to read as follows:

Section 4-120. The registration of any registered voter may be canceled only for one of the following reasons: Written notice from the voter; death; conviction of a felony; judicial determination of mental incapacitation under Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes; registration in another county or state; or failure to respond to a confirmation of address mailing and failure to vote as prescribed in Section ~~21~~ 4-120.2 of this ~~act~~ title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
