AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to prisons and reformatories;  
amending 57 O.S. 1991, Section 503, as amended by  
Section 5, Chapter 364, O.S.L. 1992 (57 O.S. Supp.  
1997, Section 503), which relates to the State  
Board of Corrections; clarifying language; and  
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 1991, Section 503, as  
amended by Section 5, Chapter 364, O.S.L. 1992 (57 O.S. Supp. 1997,  
Section 503), is amended to read as follows:

Section 503. There is hereby created the State Board of  
Corrections which shall be the governing board of the Department of  
Corrections ~~herein~~ created by Section 505 of this title. The Board  
shall consist of seven (7) members who shall be appointed by the  
Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. One member  
shall be appointed from each of the six congressional districts, and  
the seventh member shall be appointed from the state at large. The  
terms of office of two members shall expire on March 15, 1969, and  
each six (6) years thereafter; the terms of two members shall expire  
on March 15, 1971, and each six (6) years thereafter; and the terms

of three members shall expire on March 15, 1973, and each six (6) years thereafter. Not more than four members of the Board shall be of the same political party. Any member of the Board may be removed from office in the manner provided by law for the removal of officers not subject to impeachment. Vacancies on the Board shall be filled for the unexpired term.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
