AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to criminal procedure; amending 22 O.S. 1991, Section 37.1, which relates to off-duty law enforcement officers; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 22 O.S. 1991, Section 37.1, is amended to read as follows:

Section 37.1 An "off-duty" law enforcement officer in official uniform in attendance at a public function, event or assemblage of people shall have the same powers and obligations as when ~~he~~ the officer is "on-duty".

Nothing herein shall impose liability upon the governmental entity, by whom the law enforcement officer is employed, for actions of the said officer in the course of ~~his~~ the employment of the officer by a nongovernmental entity.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
