AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; eliminating tenure in higher education; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3102.1 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Beginning July 1, 1998, no more tenure will be allowed to be awarded to any employee within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education. Persons who currently have tenure shall be allowed to retain such tenure.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1998.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
