AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to insurance; requiring the Insurance Department to publish certain information; making information available to the public; providing for a fee; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 310.3 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Insurance Department shall compile and publish the text of Oklahoma statutes and Insurance Department rules that apply to insurers that issue motor vehicle insurance coverage in this state in their dealings with insured parties. The publication shall include, but not be limited to, statutes and rules on unfair practices and statutes and rules limiting the authority of insurers to cancel policies or increase premium rates.

B. The Insurance Commissioner shall make the publication available to the public, upon request. The Commissioner may charge a fee for the publication, not exceeding the cost of printing the document.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
