AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the use of public transportation;
amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 500.6, which relates
to travel; clarifying language; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 500.6, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 500.6 A. Travel by any state officer or employee on
official state business on any privately owned or chartered airplane
may be reimbursed in an amount which, when added to per diem and
reimbursement for lodging for that trip, does not exceed the
equivalent of automobile mileage plus per diem and reimbursement for
lodging had a privately owned automobile been used for the trip. The
provisions of Section 500.4 of this title shall apply to calculation
of automobile mileage equivalent in this section.

B. Upon completion of each trip, the pilot of any airplane
owned by this state shall enter into a record book the names of all
passengers on the airplane, date, destination, mileage, purpose, and
expense of the trip. The pilot shall sign each entry in the record
book. ~~Said~~ The record book may be inspected by the State Auditor
and Inspector.

C. Expenses of the trip are to be charged to the state departments or agencies of the officers or employees using the airplane. For the purposes of this section, the term expense of the trip shall include but is not limited to the cost of operating the airplane, the mileage of the trip, and the salary of the pilot.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
